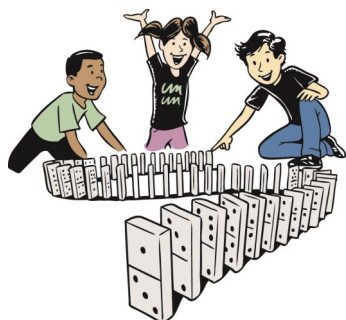
OPEN REGISTRATION (IN PERSON)

The Auburn Hills Public Library is pleased to offer our very popular summer reading program so that children can keep up their reading skills during the summer. Our program is filled with reading, games, prizes and fun activities for all ages.

** If your child does not live in Auburn Hills, they can obtain an Auburn Hills Library Card by showing proof of enrollment in a school located in Auburn Hills or the Avondale School District **



READING PROGRAM – Read books and earn prizes!

Bouncing Babies is for children from birth to 2 years of age. Parents complete literacy activities with their baby and receive a book upon completion.

Little Listeners is for children who are under 3 years of age. Parents read five books of their choice per week to their children. Toddlers will have a sticker chart at the library, and receive one prize per week as they visit.

Pathfinders is for children three years of age through entering First Grade. Children listen to five books each week, then come to the library to complete a sticker chart and earn a trip to the “Treasure Chest” for a prize!

Trailblazers is for children who are entering 2nd through 5th Grade. They will set a realistic reading goal for themselves, choose books to read and earn “Library Loot” to spend in our prize store.



YOUTH SUMMER READING ACTIVITIES

Little Listeners • Thursdays 10:30 am

A story time program for children from birth to 3 years old with an adult. This program lasts approximately 20 minutes followed by free play. Bouncing Babies are also welcome to join this program.

Pathfinders • Tuesdays 10:30 am • Wednesdays 7:00 pm

This features our story time format on some weeks, but also includes some weeks of entertainment by outside performers. It lasts approx. 35 - 45 minutes.

Trailblazers • Wednesdays 7:00 pm

This activity will be different each week and will be related to our “**Build A Better World**” summer theme. This program lasts 1 hour.

MakerSpace • Fridays 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm, Saturdays 10:30 am - 5:00 pm, week of July 4th

Each weekend during the program and throughout the first week of July we will offer a thematic drop-in MakerSpace for parents and children.

Special Events • Times and dates will be given out with your registration packet.

Featured special events include: Joel Tacey’s Book Builder Magical Comedy Show, The RJ Spangler Jazz Trio, Family Disney Trivia, Family Book Bingo, Family Gaming Days, Wildlife Safari, Storytellers, the Planetarium and more!
